I am excited to start this school year and have high expectations for a wonderful and productive semester. My name is Mrs. Young and I am one of the Science Teachers at Bedford Junior High School. This is my second year teaching here and I LOVE the students and the school community. I live in the Ann Arbor area. I have three children: Isabella 6, Gabriella 4, Connor 2 1/2, and Amelia 9 months. My husband, Matthew, is very supportive and understands the importance of my commitment to my students. For students to be successful in my class, organizational skills and respectable behavior are a must! To assist students with their organizational skills, it is suggested that students have the following items, for greater success, **DAILY: Chrome books (charged daily), #2 pencils, colored ink pen (black or blue and red), loose-leaf paper, and a spiral notebook (1 for each quarter), two pocket folder, colored pencils, glue, and scissors.** There may be more needs as labs, projects (poster boards) and homework are assigned, and your student will be notified in advanced of those needs. Students will be required to keep all assignments and notes in their spirals to use as a study tool. This teaches students the practice of organizational skills, responsibility and will prepare them for their quizzes, chapter tests and the final exams, and can be saved to use as a study tool for future tests. ***If there is a hardship and these items cannot be purchased please see me/or call immediately.***
